

### APPLICATION FOR LIMITED PERFORMANCE PROGRAM (LPP) LISTING

A LPP listing is reserved for dogs that are unregistrable into the ADBA registry. Dogs accepted for Limited Performance Program MUST be spayed or neutered . A LPP listing is NOT to be viewed as an alternate form of registration. A LPP listing is to certify purebred status as is reasonably possible using visual inspection for the purpose of entering fun classes at ADBSI Sanctioned Shows. A LPP identification card will be sent displaying a photo of the dog with ownership information when the dog is accepted.

#### LPP application must be accompanied with the following documentation:

- A. Two or more recent color photographs. Photos submitted (color only) must be of the size and quality for easy visual identification of dog .
  1. One photo featuring the dog from the side, in a standing position;
  2. One photo featuring a full view of the dog from the front. Position can be standing or sitting, as long as the photo shows the dog's entire front, (head to feet). One of these photos will be featured on the LPP card, so pics must be of the highest quality possible.
- B. Certification that the dog has been either spayed or neutered. If spay/neuter certificate is unavailable, a signed document of spay/neuter verification supplied by veterinarian will be accepted.
- C. Check or Money order for \$25.00. (Visa & Master Card accepted)

A LPP card will be sent when the dog is accepted. Dogs not accepted will be refunded the application fee (minus a \$5.00 processing fee).

### **RULES GOVERNING LIMITED PERFORMANCE PROGRAM**

All application forms and photographs submitted become the property of the ADBA, and will not be returned.

Dogs accepted for the Limited Performance Program are to be allowed entry to all fun events/classes held at the discretion of each club at all ADBSI sanctioned shows. As events are added for LPP dogs, they will be announced in the APBT GAZETTE magazine and on the ADBA website. ( [www.adba.cc](http://www.adba.cc))

Dogs accepted for the Limited Performance Program MUST be spayed or neutered, ensuring they will not enter the APBT gene pool. The LPP Card is not transferable. In the event that the dog is sold to a new owner, the LPP Card should be returned to the ADBA and included with a new application for the Limited Performance Program completed by the new owner. The fee for transfer of ownership will be \$20.00. This procedure will ensure any LPP points earned will be transferred to the new owner.

ADBA reserves the right to revoke a dogs Limited Performance Program (LPP) listing at any time for cause. ADBA reserves the right to change any/all rules, fees, etc. without notice.
